Countering Violent Extremism and Radicalization

A discussion of strategy and doctrine that are being used to counter and/or mitigate violent extremism - radicalization at the individual and group levels. Focus will be on religiously-motivated extremism – radicalization. What has worked and not worked? Why and why not? How can these work in a democratic system? What do we know and don't know? What are best practices? Why does one identity group/community have a low incidence of violent extremism and a similar identity group/community in another location have a much higher rate? Where does community resilience or resistance to violent extremism fit in? What happens if nothing is done?
